I. Enterprise Discussion

A. Schedule of Events (SOE) Enterprise highlights, available [online](#)

❖ WCOSS:

- 24-hour parallel production test on Tide on November 23 to test Tide’s functionality after the metadata-data separation. Only users with devonprod access will be allowed on Tide during the test.
- NCO/IDSB will set up the full NCEP Production Job Suite in parallel on Tide with the new version of the GEFS and all of its downstream dependencies on December 1. Production output will still be disseminated off Gyre. Production will be switched from Gyre to Tide on December 2 in order to implement the new version of the GEFS into operations. Only users with devonprod access will be able to log onto Tide on December 1. After the production switch on Dec. 2, Gyre will be configured as the development WCOSS system but will run in parallel production until December 3. Full developer access will be restored on Gyre on December 3.
- Production switch back from Tide to Gyre on December 7.
