**A. Schedule of Events (SOE) Enterprise highlights, available [online](#)**

❖ WCOSS:

- Tide/Luna intentional outage on November 9 to allow network changes to proceed with the highest likelihood of success. Jobs will be quiesced starting at 1300Z. The network work will start at 1400Z and is supposed to only take 30 minutes to an hour. The systems will then be returned to developers. Shared storage will be unmounted during this outage as well.
- Parallel production test planned for the week of November 14, in order to test the NAM upgrade and all of its downstream components. During the test, the development WCOSS will be unavailable to those who don't have devonprod access.

**C. Proposed upcoming NCO RFC(s) with potential Enterprise effect:**

- ❖ GFS MOS implementation on the Crays, November 15 at 1300Z.
- ❖ RAP bug fix to update the terrain file and smooth the southern boundary in South America and prevent forecast failures like those that occurred on Oct. 26 and 27. RAP post and smartinit jobs will be updated to run the smartinit domains in parallel, to bring the runtime back to what it was before the most recent upgrade. To be implemented on November 15 at 1515Z.
- ❖ Multiple decoder upgrades on WCOSS. The following decoders are being modified: dcamdr, dctama, dcasev, dcalps, dcusgs, dcbuoy. Specifics will be sent on request. To be implemented on November 16 at 1200Z.
- ❖ National Blend of Models and EKDMOS upgrades on the Crays, November 15 at 1400Z.
- ❖ Nearshore Wave Prediction System upgrade to v1.1.3, to add 13 more coastal WFO domains for Western, Pacific, and Alaska Regions. Specifics will be sent on request. To be implemented on November 17 at 1200Z.
