



Waves Summer School 2015

The waves group at NCEP/NOAA in partnership with the University System of Maryland Foundation will be offering a one-week workshop at the University of Maryland (UMD) College Park campus, July 13 - 17, 2015.

This workshop will be similar to the one hosted in January 2013 (<http://polar.ncep.noaa.gov/waves/workshops/WinterSchool2013>).

Topics covered will include wave dynamics and modeling, basics of the WAVEWATCH III® model, grid structures, numerics and oceanic and nearshore applications. The workshop will consist of morning lectures and afternoon tutorials.

Registration for the Waves Summer School will cover UMD administrative costs and IT support, and is expected to be in the \$200-\$300 range. There are 20 spots available and acceptance will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Parking is available in lots within walking distance at \$15/day.
